

## Kiyoh customer review module installation for Woocommerce

- 1) Extract module archive
- 2) Upload folder 'kiyoh-customerreview' to your wordpress root/wp-content/plugins/
- 3) Login to wordpress administration panel
- 4) Go to Main Menu=>Plugins=> Installed plugins
- 5) Activate module 'Kiyoh Customerreview'
- 6) Go to Main Menu=>Kiyoh Settings. Fill in the settings and click "Save changes"
- 7) Go to Main Menu=>Appearance=>Widgets and drag and drop 'Kiyoh review' widget to desired area (it depends on you theme capabilities and settings) and fill 'company id' field.
- 8) done. Check if all works on front-end.

Setup a cronjob (**only for option 'Email send method'** with value '**Send emails from my server'** require a cron to be configured):

SSH way for Linux:

- 1) Open crontab:

```
crontab -e
```

- 2) Then add a line like below in it.

```
*/10 * * * * php /var/www/example.com/htdocs/wp-cron.php > /dev/null 2>&1
```

cPanel way:

- 1) In the Advanced section of the cPanel home screen, click Cron jobs.
- 2) Under Add New Cron Job, in the Common Settings list box, select once in 10 minutes.
- 3) In the Command text box, type the following line. Replace **PATH** with your own path to wordpress installation:

```
php -q PATH/wp-cron.php
```

PS: Kiyoh does not send email twice to the same email address! When testing multiple times with the same email address it will not work because of this security.
